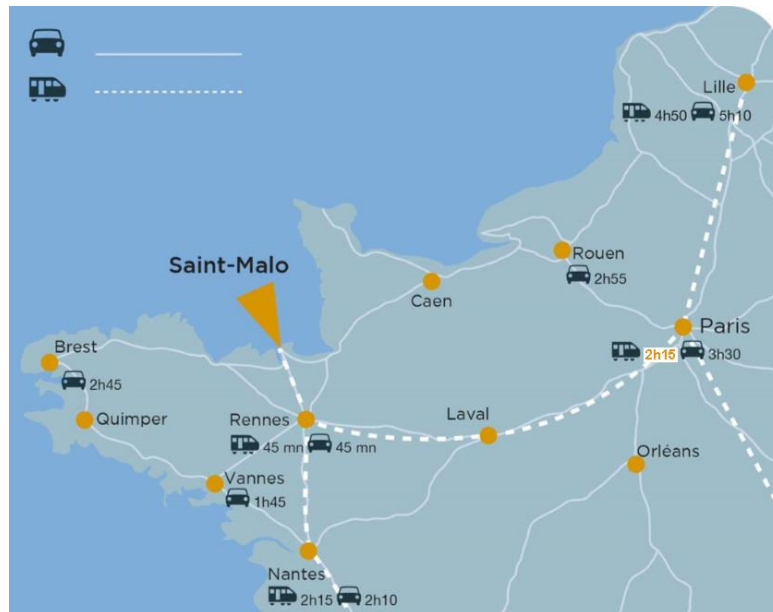


HOW TO GET TO LE GRAND LARGE VENUE



Arriving by plane:

1/ Landing at **Roissy Charles De Gaulle (CDG) airport**, you may either:

- **Take a TGV train to Rennes and then a connection to Saint-Malo (around 4 hour trip).**
- Take an Air France bus shuttle to Montparnasse railway station and then take a TGV to Saint-Malo
- Rent a car in the airport for a 4.5-hour trip by motorways A11/A13 (through Rennes) or A13/A84 (through Caen)

2/ Landing at **Orly airport**, you may either:

- Take an Air France bus shuttle to Montparnasse railway station and then take a TGV to Saint-Malo (either direct or via Rennes)
- Rent a car at the airport for a 4.5-hour trip by motorways A11/A13 (via Rennes) or A13/A84 (via Caen)

3/ Landing at **Rennes –Saint Jacques Airport**, you may either:

- Take a bus or a taxi to Rennes railway station. Then take a direct train to Saint-Malo.
- Rent a car or take a taxi. (*) Saint-Malo is 75 km away, less than 1-hour trip.

4/ Landing at **Dinard—Pleurtuit Airport** you may:

Take a taxi (*) or rent a car. Saint-Malo is 20 min. away from the airport.
The taxi's fare is about 30 euros.

*NB. There are daily flights from London Stansted or Nottingham to Dinard
There are daily connections between Heathrow and Stansted airport for international flights.
National Express coaches run direct between the airports every 30-60min. Journey time:
90min. Cost: from £19*

() Direct shuttles from Rennes or Dinard Airport may be organized when there are at least 2 passengers.*



Arriving by train:

- 1/ From **Paris Montparnasse railway station** (town center):
Direct TGV train to Saint Malo in 2h15.
- 2/ From **Roissy CDG airport**:
Air France bus shuttle to Paris Montparnasse railway station and then connection to Saint-Malo.
- 3/ From **Orly airport**:
Bus shuttle to Paris Montparnasse railway station and then connection to Saint-Malo.
- 4/ From **Rennes Airport**:
Bus or taxi until Rennes railway station and then connection to Saint- Malo



Arriving by car:

- 1/ From **Paris**: 3.5 hours by motorways :
 - A11/A13 (through Rennes)
 - A13/A84 (through Caen)
- 2/ From **Rennes**: 1 hour by motorway
- 3/ From **Nantes**: 2 hours by motorway



Arriving by boat:

- From **Portsmouth (UK)**:
